



Inadvertent Whistle





The ball becomes dead and the down is ended.





If there are NO penalties, or if the penalty for a foul during the down is DECLINED:

 replayed if the whistle occurs while a legal forward pass or snap is in flight OR during a legal kick.



Loose ball following a backward pass, fumble, illegal forward pass or illegal kick team last in possession can:

- Replay the down
- Count the down & put the ball in play where possession was lost.



In player possession

- Replay the down.
- Count the down, accept the results of the play at the spot of the inadvertent whistle.



If the penalty for a foul during the down is ACCEPTED

penalty takes precedence



YOU MAKE THE CALL

On fourth down, K punts to R1, who catches the ball on R's 10-yard line. R1, in an attempt to setup his blocking, circles back into his end zone. R2 clips at the 5-yard line while R1 is still in the end zone, and an inadvertent whistle sounds at this time.



- A period must be extended by an untimed down if there was an <u>inadvertent whistle</u>.
- The clock shall start with the ready-for-play signal for other than a free kick if the clock was stopped because of an <u>inadvertent whistle</u>.
- A free kick is not repeated unless: There is an inadvertent whistle during the kick.



Sounding Whistle

OFFICIAL COVERING RUNNER

- Find ball before sounding whistle.
- When ball becomes dead, sound whistle quickly and loudly.
- Move in quickly to be certain all action stops on whistle.



Sounding Whistle

ALL OFFICIALS

- Find ball before sounding whistle.
- See ball in possession of runner who is down or forward progress stopped
- Ball can be kept in view when officials are in position and alert.
- Use bean bag to mark spot of ball if whistle is sounded inadvertently.

01. A period is never extended because of an inadvertent whistle.

FALSE

02. If during the last timed down of the 4th period, A1 advances beyond the neutral zone and an inadvertent whistle is blown. A may request a replay during an untimed down.

TRUE

03. If an inadvertent whistle sounds during the last timed down of a period, the period must be extended by an untimed down.

TRUE

04. If A1 has advanced beyond the neutral zone during the last timed down of a period but an inadvertent whistle sounded, Team A may choose the result of the play and the period is automatically extended.

TRUE

05. It is a safety if A1's fumble is declared dead in B's end zone, other than from an inadvertent whistle, and no player of either team is in possession.

FALSE

06. The clock starts on the ready-for-play signal following an inadvertent whistle.

TRUE

07. The period must be extended if during the last timed down there was an inadvertent whistle and the down is replayed.

TRUE

08. An official's inadvertent whistle causes the ball to become dead.

TRUE

09. Any foul, which occurs after an inadvertent whistle, can only be a dead ball foul.

TRUE

10. If there is an inadvertent whistle during a forward pass, but prior to the whistle A1 commits pass interference, the down is replayed if the penalty is accepted.

FALSE

11. If an inadvertent whistle sounds but the penalty is accepted for a foul which occurred prior to the whistle, the inadvertent whistle coverage is ignored.

TRUE

12. If a legal forward pass is in flight when the whistle sounds, an automatic replay results.

TRUE

13. If an official sounds his whistle when K1 first touches a scrimmage kick beyond the neutral zone, it is an inadvertent whistle and the down will be replayed.

TRUE

14. If an inadvertent whistle sounds during the snap, the down shall be replayed.

TRUE

15. If R1 blocks K1's punt and just before R1 recovers in K's end zone, there is an inadvertent whistle, the down shall be replayed.

TRUE

16. If K1's first touching of a scrimmage kick beyond the neutral zone causes an official to blow his whistle inadvertently, it is R's ball at the spot of the first touching.

FALSE

17. If there is first touching of a scrimmage kick by K1 and, thereafter, while the ball is loose an inadvertent whistle sounds, the down must be replayed.

TRUE

18. If A1 fumbles beyond the line and an inadvertent whistle sounds while the ball is loose, A may either take the ball at the spot A1 fumbled or ask for a replay of the down.

TRUE

19. The provisions of the inadvertent whistle rule apply if the whistle sounds when the ball is loose on either side of the line during a backward pass.

TRUE

20. If the whistle sounds when the ball is loose behind the line following a change of possession, it results in an automatic replay.

FALSE

21. If the whistle sounds when the ball is loose on a fumble by A I beyond the line, the down automatically counts and it is A's ball at the spot of the fumble.

FALSE

22. If the whistle sounds during an illegal forward pass, the penalty is automatically accepted and the whistle is ignored.

FALSE

23. If A1 fumbles 10 yards behind his line of scrimmage and the whistle sounds while the ball is loose, Team A may choose to replay the down.

TRUE

24. If A1 fumbles behind the neutral zone and an inadvertent whistle sounds while the ball is loose, Team A automatically gets the ball at the spot of the fumble and the down counts.

FALSE

25. If there is an inadvertent whistle while the ball is loose following a fumble by A1 beyond the neutral zone, the ball is awarded to the fumbling team at the spot where the ball was when the whistle blew with no choice of replaying the down.

FALSE

26. If Al fumbles the ball into B's end zone, and while the ball is loose there an official blows an inadvertent whistle, it is a touchdown for A.

FALSE

27. If a player is in possession at the time of an inadvertent whistle, his team has a choice of accepting the play or replaying the down.

TRUE

28. If the whistle sounds when Al is running beyond the line, the down automatically counts and it is A's ball at the spot it became dead.

FALSE

29. If an inadvertent whistle sounds when A1 is in possession, the down may be replayed.

TRUE

30. Following a change of possession, if an inadvertent whistle is sounded, the down must be replayed.

FALSE

31. If an inadvertent whistle sounds with B1 in possession, Team B may not retain possession.
